Personal Information Provided by You. The personal information that we collect depends on the context of your interactions with us and the Services, the choices you make, and the products and features you use.

Payment Data. We may collect data necessary to process your payment instrument number, and the security code associated with your payment instrument. All

We automatically collect certain information when you visit, use, or navigate the Services. HOW DO WE KEEP YOUR INFORMATION SAFE? In Short: We aim to protect your personal information through a system of organisational and technical security measures. We have implemented appropriate and reasonable technical and organisational security measures designed to protect the security of any personal information we process.
